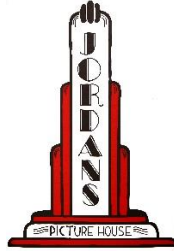

There have been no screenings since February 2020, and on February 22nd in order to provide some relief from the boredom of lockdown we arranged a ZOOM Question and Answer session with Armando Iannucci, the Director of “The Death of Stalin,” (2017) screened at JPH in April 2018, and numerous other productions. Described in the introduction as a “sparkling polymath” Armando answered a number of questions from the assembled ZOOM audience of over 40 on his work as a writer and film director and on his life experience. While it certainly proved its worth in terms of an interesting perspective on a stellar career it also raised a useful £700+ for Wycombe Homeless Connection and we are very grateful for everyone’s donations.

It is only now, in April that we are beginning to dare think that our sixth season could start on Friday September 10th 2021 and we have been busy working on the potential programme. We have emailed out a list of 26 candidate films for our new season asking our Members to pick 14, which will be screened either on Fridays or Tuesdays. In addition there will be a small number of foreign language films to be screened on Sundays to a reduced audience of no more than 30, to allow visibility of the subtitles.
